Eero Saarinen



American / Finnish Designer

Eero Saarinen was an architect and furniture designer who spent his early childhood years in Finland but made his reputation in the US. He studied sculpture in Paris and architecture at Yale.

Saarinen first received critical recognition for a chair designed together with Charles Eames for the "Organic Design in Home Furnishings" competition in 1940, for which they received first prize.

His elegant Pedestal and Tulip chair collection from 1957 are instantly recognisable. The range was so named because of the slender, elegant stem like pedestals and organic shapes. Saarinen wanted to escape the tedium of legs and square surfaces that had encroached on furniture of the time and created a range with smooth lines and no edges. He wished to obliterate the "slum of legs in the US home".
