Danish Designer

Hans J. Wegner, the son of a shoe-maker is credited with making mid-century Danish design popular on an international scale. He began his career as a cabinetmaker in 1931 and subsequently entered the Copenhagen School of Arts & Crafts.

He received his architectural degree in 1938. He worked as a furniture designer in Arne Jacobsen's architectural office before establishing his own office in 1943.

Wegner believed that furniture should be functional as well as beautiful. He is one of the most prolific Danish designers to date with more than 500 different chair designs.

Wegner's furniture designs won worldwide recognition and his chairs are found in the permanent collections of the world's most prestigious museums.
